Nursing Scholarships for 2022

Australia Awards In-PNG Scholarships provide training in priority areas identified by the Governments of Papua New Guinea and Australia, delivered through selected partner institutions in Papua New Guinea. Nursing scholars and graduates contribute to quality health outcomes across PNG including in rural and remote communities.

Important: Please read all information carefully before completing your application.

This application form is for study in PNG only (not Australia). You must complete your application in English.

The scholarship is available for study at:

- Lae School of Nursing
- Lutheran School of Nursing

Eligibility requirements

You must meet the following requirements to be considered for a scholarship.

- be a non-school leaver (i.e. not be applying directly after completing secondary school)
- be a citizen of PNG and residing in PNG at the time of application
- not have been convicted of a criminal offence
- not have been terminated from a previous Australia Awards scholarship for misconduct.
- completed Grade 12 with a minimum GPA 2.75 and a minimum grade B in Biology and Chemistry and Language & Literature and C in Advance Math or A in General Math
- OR matriculation upgrade (DODL/FODE) minimum GPA 3.0 and minimum subject grades as above
- meet the additional conditions of entry for the institution of your choice (see page 2)

(Note: UPNG CTCS six-month upgrade is not accepted by either School of Nursing)

Required supporting documents

You must submit the following documents with your application:

- One recent passport size ID photo with your name and signature on the back of the photo (scanned/electronic copy is acceptable)
- Certified copy of your Grade 12 Higher School Certificate/DODL/FODE Transcript
- Certified copy of your most recent academic certificate (DODL/CODE studies after Grade 12) (if applicable)
- Certified copy of your most recent academic transcript/s
- Certified copy of one of the following: your passport bio page or NID card or birth certificate or photo ID such as driver license, school ID card or staff ID card
- A letter of reference from a community leader (e.g. school principal, pastor, village chief or employer).

Successful applications

If you are offered a scholarship, you will need to:

- sign a contract and be bound by the scholarship conditions
- be accepted for full-time into study at the institution! identified in your scholarship offer for the duration of the award
- if necessary, live on-campus unaccompanied (no! family)
- meet all other conditions of a scholarship award.

Fraudulent documents and false statements

The Australian Government takes a zero-tolerance approach to fraud. All application documents will be verified and if found fraudulent, applicants will be excluded for consideration for this scholarship and any future Australia Awards. If application fraud is detected after a scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be immediately terminated.

Intake 2022 selections, shortlisting and placements of successful candidates may be delayed and timeframe extended due to the current COVID-19 context.

COMPLETING AND SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION

This application form can be completed electronically as a PDF. But, you can only save the completed (or partially completed) application if your computer has Adobe Acrobat DC or the latest version of Adobe.

Otherwise you can print the application form and complete by hand or complete the application form electronically in one session and print the application before closing.

Remember: if do not have the latest version of Adobe, the information you type in will not be saved once you close the form.

You may submit your application using any of the three methods below:

- By email:** You attach the application form (completed electronically or by hand) as an PDF email attachment (renamed with your name). Email your application to: nursing@australiaawardspng.org
- By post:** You can send direct mail or courier your application to the Australia Awards address below. Application envelopes which are date stamped after the closing date or received 14 days after the closing date will not be considered eligible.
- In person:** You may also submit your application directly to each of the colleges below, but you **MUST** call the Australia Awards In-PNG Scholarships team immediately to register that you have submitted your application.

College Admissions Policy: Pregnancy and Young Infants

- Students cannot commence study if they are pregnant or nursing an infant of less than 12 months of age
- If awarded a scholarship, Australia Awards PNG can consider a 12 month deferral (subject to approval)
- Where a student becomes pregnant during her study, the student will be suspended from study until her infant is at least 12 months of age (Lae) and two years of age (Lutheran). In these circumstance, the scholarship can be placed on suspension and recommenced.
- Both Schools of Nursing require a letter from the student’s spouse supporting return to study.
- Lutheran requires a consent letter from spouse for new students who are married
- All students must live on campus unaccompanied unless approved otherwise by your institution

This question aims to assess your reflective and problem solving skills and how you will apply your skills to successfully complete your course of study.

Q2: Describe how you achieved a long term goal or a particular skill (for example, an education qualification, achievement in sport, learning a skill such as playing a musical instrument, a handicraft etc.). What was your goal? What challenges did you face in your journey towards your goal? How did you overcome these challenges?

This question aims to assess your determination, your ability to prioritise and to make use of your available resources. The goal may be a personal goal or a goal within your community.

Q3: After graduation, where will you work and what skills will you use to meet the needs of your patients? Explain why this clinical setting and your skills will be important to you, your patients and PNG?

This question aims to assess your interest in nursing, your understanding of nursing specialisation and your commitment to providing front-line health services in PNG.

Q4: : Describe a mistake you made during the past few years:

- What was the mistake?
- What you learned from it?

This question aims to assess your reflective and analytical skills, also how you are able to identify problems and respond appropriately.
