Australia Awards Scholarships Intake 2024

Undergraduate Degrees



Australia Awards Scholarships are prestigious international awards offered by the Australian Government to Papua New Guinea's current and future leaders.

To be eligible for an undergraduate award you must:

- be a citizen of and reside in Papua New Guinea
- have at least two years of work experience in your sector
- study a topic that cannot be studied in PNG and/or be a person living with disability
- have successfully completed your year 12 program of study
- have high English language proficiency
- meet the Australian institution course requirements and all visa requirements
- be committed to returning to PNG
- public servants must meet the GoPNG training bid process requirements. Please refer to www.dpm.gov.pg for more information.

You are not eligible if you:

- currently hold an Australian Government-funded scholarship
- hold citizenship or permanent resident status in Australia
- are married or engaged to be married to someone who holds or is entitled to hold citizenship or permanent residency in Australia.

Undergraduate level scholarships:

We offer a very limited number of undergraduate scholarships each year. Undergraduate awards are restricted to programs that cannot be studied in PNG and/or people living with disability. All undergraduate applicants must meet the eligibility criteria for scholarships, including at least two years of work experience.

Eligible undergraduate programs:

Programs that may be considered for undergraduate level scholarships include:

- agribusiness
- animal and veterinary science
- aviation management
- biosecurity and quarantine
- disability studies and developmental, inclusive and special education
- forensic science
- maritime management
- sports science and sports management.

Study programs not available for undergraduate awards:

We do not accept scholarship applications for undergraduate study in arts, business, commerce, communications, computer science, IT, law, justice studies, management, nursing, public policy, or any other programs not listed under eligible undergraduate programs.

Application requirements for undergraduate scholarships:

- completed OASIS application
- certified high school certificate/diploma and transcript of grades
- certified valid ID (NID or valid passport or driver's license + birth certificate)
- reintegration plan (use AAPNG template)
- academic referee report (use AAPNG template)
- professional referee report (use AAPNG template)
- CV (use AAPNG template)

Interested applicants must submit an Expression of Interest via <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/AAS2024ew> on or before **28 February 2023**. If the applicant meets the eligibility criteria, the scholarship team will contact the applicant for a consultation session in February or March 2023.
