## **Application Factsheet**

The Partner Tertiary Institution (PTI) Grants are designed to empower PNG's higher education sector to improve quality and capacity across key priorityt:









#### **Grant Details**

Two AUD50,000 grants to a total of AUD100,000 are available for each Partner Tertiary Institution. The grants are available across two streams:

### Stream 1:

AUD50,000 grant for small-scale procurement of items that will improve academic or student welfare on campus or during student practical placements, and,

#### Stream 2:

AUD50,000 to support staff professional development, including workshops and collaborative opportunities with Australiant counterparts.

Institutions are eligible to apply for both grant streams

#### Eligibility criteria

To be eligible the institution must:

- 1. Have a current, signed, Service Agreement with AAPNG.
- 2. Identify projects aligned with the focus areas outlined in the PTI Grant Guidelines and the institution's strategic plan.
- Contribute to inclusion of women, persons with disability and individuals from remote areas in the proposed projects
- Submit a completed online application form on SMARTY Grants

#### **Application screening process**

- Submit an application by 11:59pm 31st March 2025
- All applications will be assessed by the Higher Education Partnerships Grants Review Panel
- Institutions will be notified of their application outcome by 30th April, 2025.
